## The band!

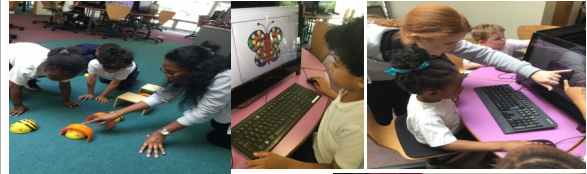


We played music as a group today in Music with Mr Bolagi. We learnt how to play together as a band.

On Thursday we went on a journey to visit the Camden Learning centre.



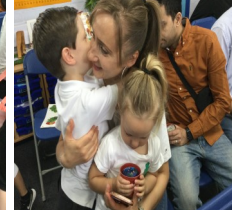
We were able to practise our computing skills and learnt to program.
