Dear Parents and Carers,

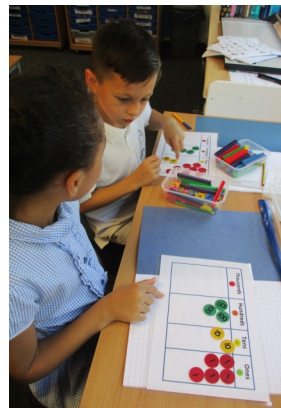
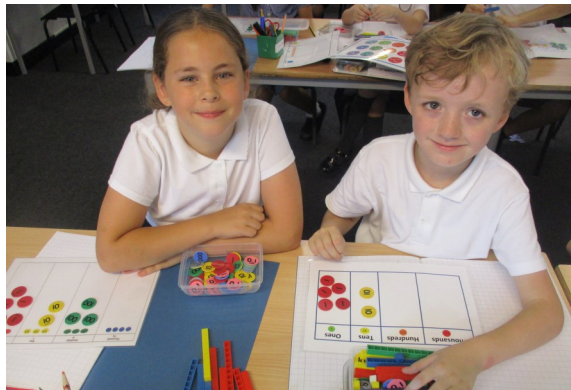

There is no school on **Friday 15th September** for children in Reception and Nursery class. **This is our Academic Review Day.**

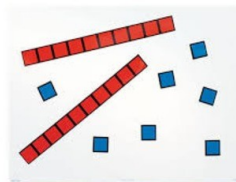
Year 6 Secondary Transfer meeting for Year 6 parents ...
