They took part in a workshop which explored the relative size and position of the Earth, Sun and Moon. All in all, it was a great day with lots of new knowledge learnt!

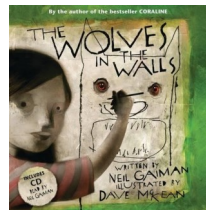


Work of the Week!
