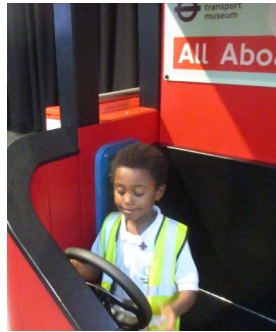

Lord is with thee.

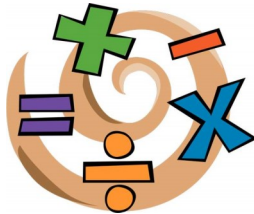
Blessed art thou among women, and

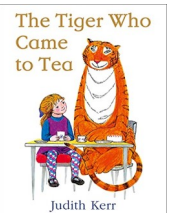
Work of the Week!
