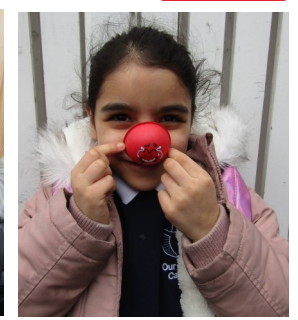
## Year 4 interview Father Mark
