9 & 10

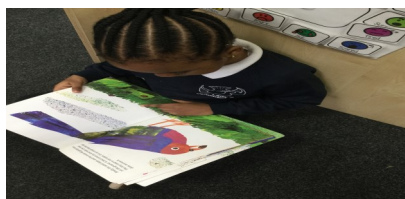
Reception have been learning to find numbers 9 & 10 in different ways. There were lots of objects that they found showing either a nine or a ten. More than they thought!

The tiny seed

We have been enjoying reading and retelling the story of the tiny seed. We have been remembering the events of the story and learning to sequence what happens at the beginning, middle and end of



the story. The tiny seed travels on a long journey through the seasons. Using our knowledge of how the seasons change helped us to understand the changes which happen to the tiny seed. We are in the season of spring. What changes to the weather, trees and plants have you seen?



They also investigated how to make 10 using two different amounts. Using the 'numicon' helped the children to find a total amount by counting on until they had counted all objects. Some children were also able to find two different amounts which total a teen number. Great Maths work!

How can you help your child with their learning?

Talk to your child about the changing seasons. What do they notice about the appearance of the trees in autumn, winter, spring and summer? Which flowers do they see growing now we are in the season of spring?
