During the Summer term we are learning about plants and animals and how they grow and change.

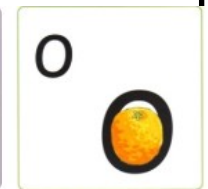
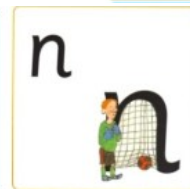
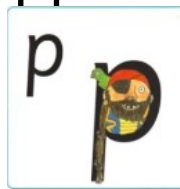
## In the Week

### Wiggly Woo

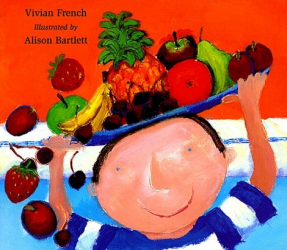
There's a worm at the bottom of my garden

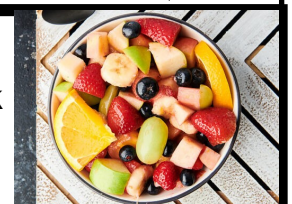
