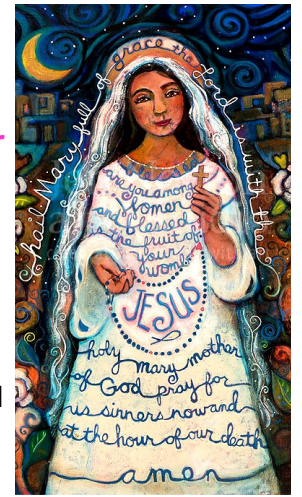


Our Prayer...
