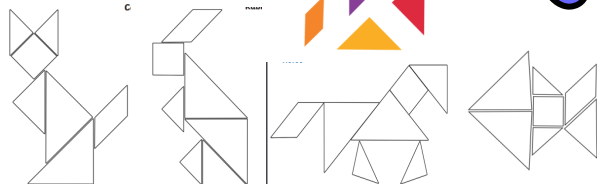
Year Reception had a very special visitor, our Bishop Nicholas.

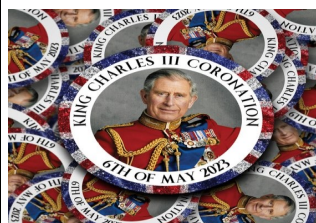
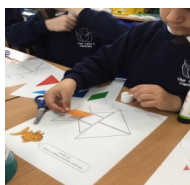
Tangrams



In Reception class. We have been learning about Tangrams.

A Tangram is a square divided into 7 different shapes. These 7 shapes have been turned and arranged to make different pictures. Above we can see a cat. What other animals have the shapes been arranged to make?

We have enjoyed moving shapes in different positions and turning shapes in different directions to make pictures. We now know that the word rotate means turn.
