In the Week

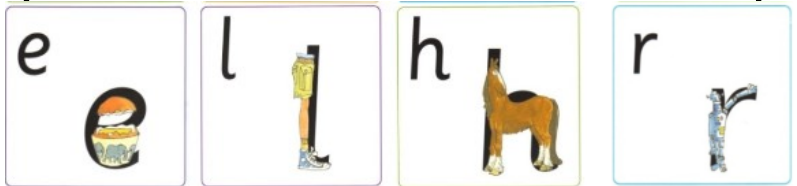


This week we read **The Odd Egg**. We drew animals that lay eggs.
