Can you read these words using the skill of Fred in your head?

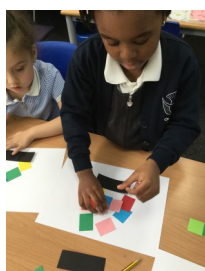
