Pentecost

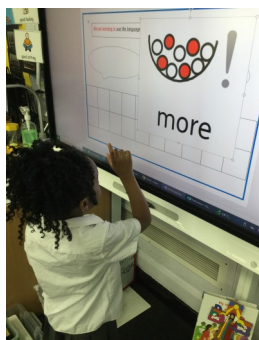

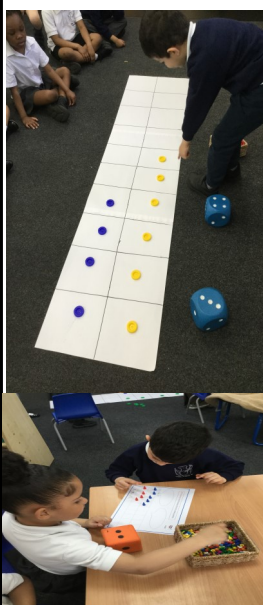

How can you help your child with their learning?

When counting larger numbers with your child check that they are counting accurately. Play counting games. Ask them questions and have conversations with them to help them talk about the amounts they have. Keep using Maths vocabulary such as: more, less, size, greater than and less than.
