their learning.



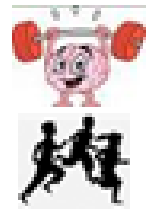
## Don't let a little worry turn into a big one...

If you or your child are worried about something or have any questions, please phone the school office and book an appointment to see their class teacher, Miss Toop, Miss Fearon or Mr Withers.






# Bringing a Packed Lunch to school

A healthy packed lunch gives our brains and bodies fuel to help us learn and play.



**Our healthy packed lunch **must not contain nuts.****

Food that you should include in your packed lunch	Food you cannot bring for your packed lunch
Fruit Vegetables 	Fruit winders 
Starchy food eg: Bread Pasta Noodles Cous cous 	Crisps Salted snacks Chocolate biscuits Cakes Muffins 
Dairy foods eg: Cheese Yoghurt 	CHOCOLATE OR SWEETS 
Meat Fish Non-dairy protein eg hummus or falafel 	Sweet or fizzy drinks Fruit juices 

**We provide water to drink at lunch time so no drinks need to be included in your packed lunch.**
