Bought a currant bun and took it away.



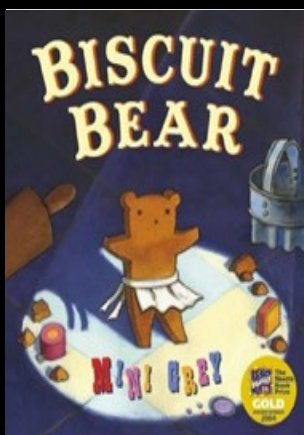
FOUR currant buns in a baker's shop,
