This week we read Jasper's Beanstalk.

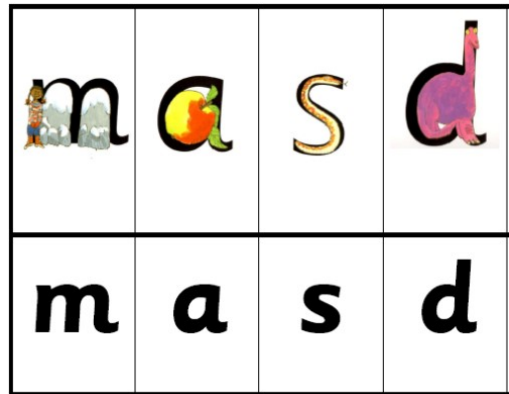

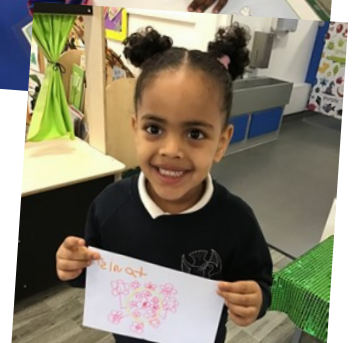
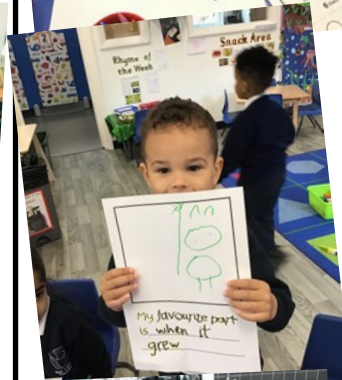
