**Thursday 3rd July** - Camden Year 6 transition day

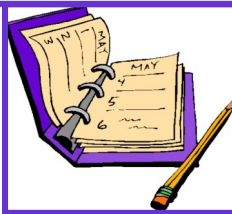
**Thursday 3rd July at 9.30am** - Year 3 attend mass at Our Lady of Hal - parents welcome to attend (leaving school at 9am)
