

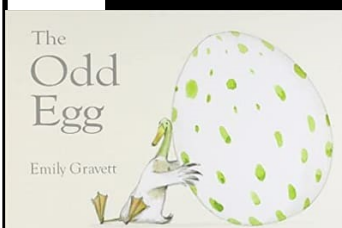
What have we been learning in the Nursery?

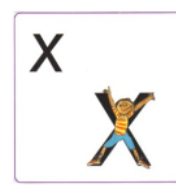
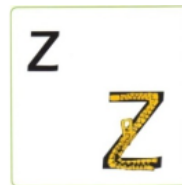


This week we read The Odd Egg.



Phonics

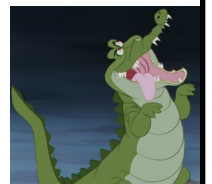
These are the sounds we learnt this week:

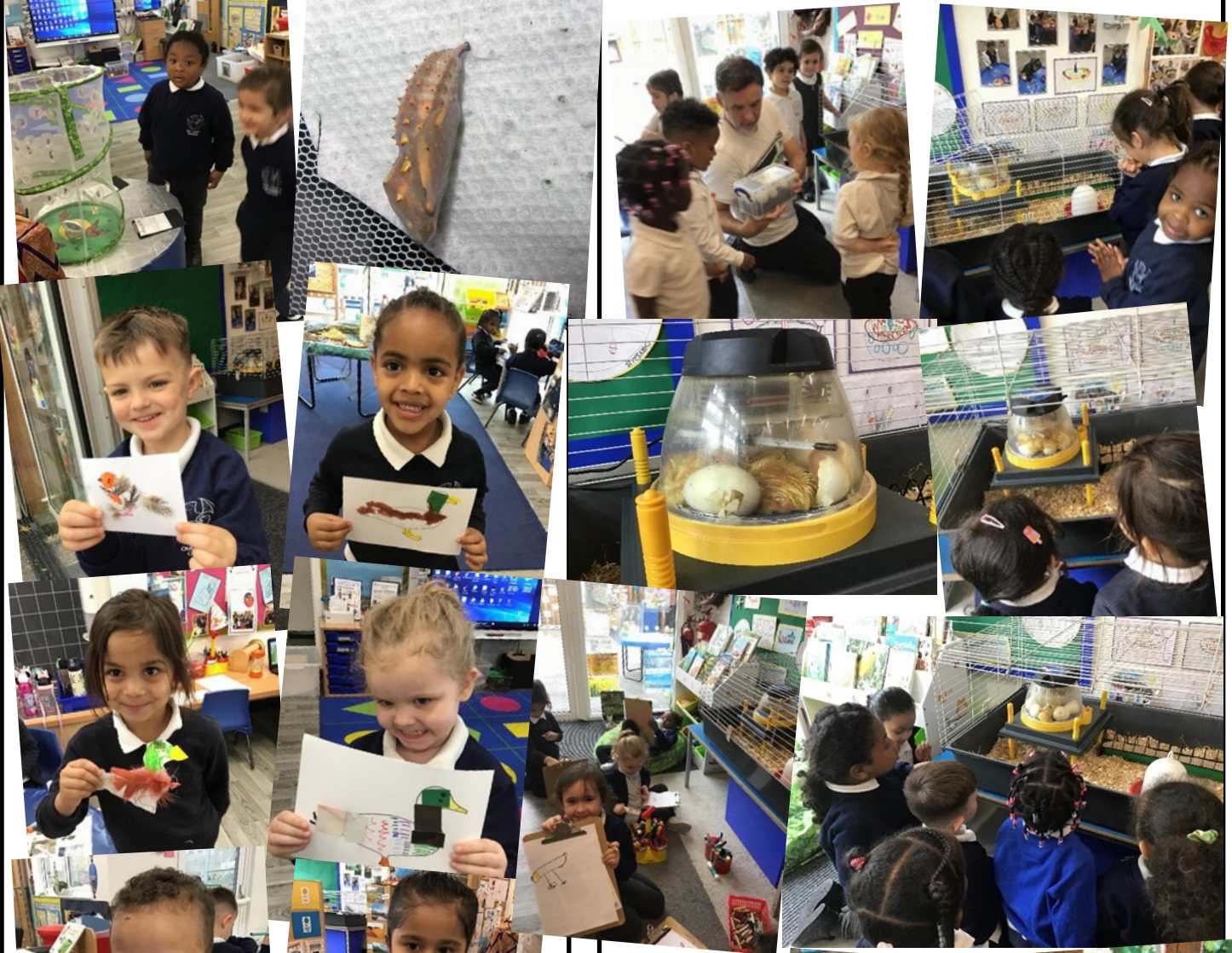
We are always really pleased to meet with you and chat things through.
