

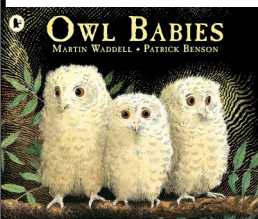
What have we been learning in the Nursery?

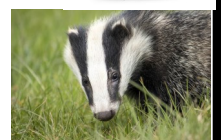
Please practise this rhyme with your child.
