Animals & their young



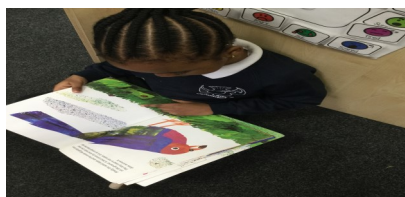
Reception have been learning to name and recognise animals and their young. During the Spring time we see baby animals being born, chicks hatching from their eggs and new growth all around us.
