Week beginning: Monday 25th November 2024

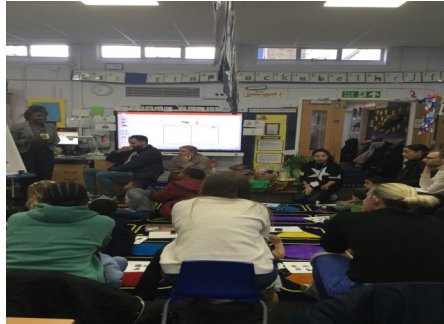
We have been learning our letters and sounds in phonics.
