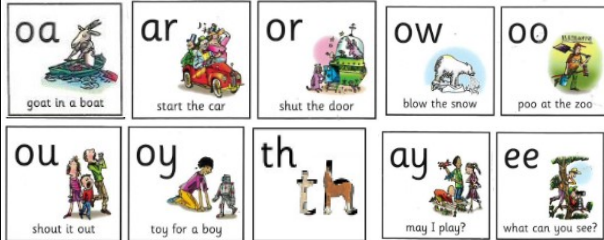


What have we been learning?

We have been learning our letters and sounds in our phonics lessons.



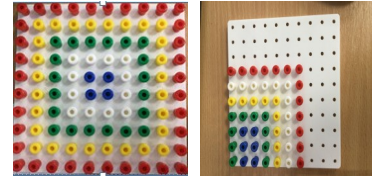
This week children have also been learning how to read words with more than one digraph in them. Words such as think have a 'th' and an 'nk'. How many digraphs can you see in the word three?

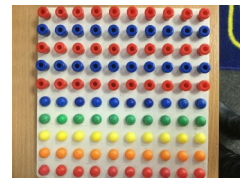


Patterns
