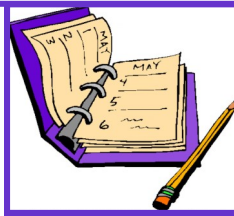

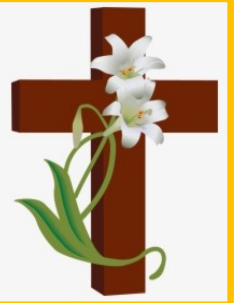

Every week a fantastic piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office).

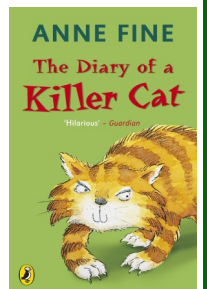
This term, Year 3 have been reading 'The Diary of a Killer Cat' by Anne Fine.
