An important deadline! Applications for Nursery and Reception class for September 2025...

If you or someone you know would like a place in Nursery or Reception for September 2025 then **applications must be made by 15th January 2025**. Applications for Reception need to be made online via www.eadmissions.org.uk and a separate school application form handed in to school. If your child is currently in Our Lady's Nursery then **you must still apply**. Please remind other parents about applying for Reception if this applies to their child. Applications to Nursery must be made directly to the school by 15th January 2025. An application form can be picked up from the school office or printed from our school website. We welcome Catholic children, children of other faiths and children with no faith too. **Mrs O'Reilly is running parent tours on Tuesday mornings at 9.30 am, to talk to prospective parents about the school and to answer questions about applications - so spread the word about our lovely school!**

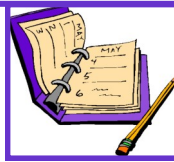

Work of the Week!

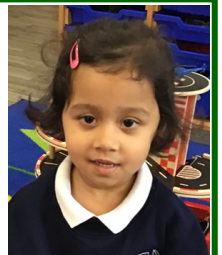
Every week a fantastic piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office).
