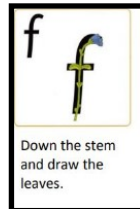
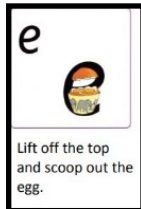


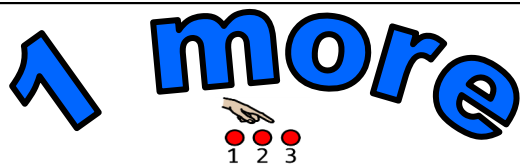
What have we been learning?

Rememberance

How can you help your child with their learning?
