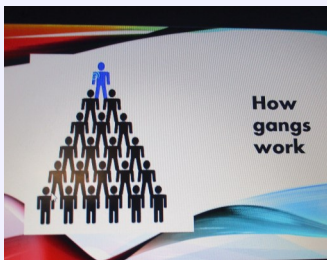
Dear parents and carers,

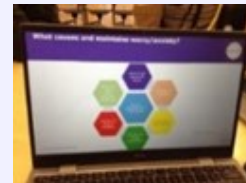
Growing against violence workshop

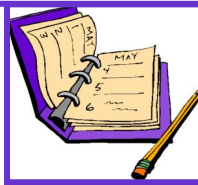
