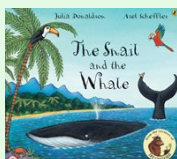
## Morning Mass with Father Mark

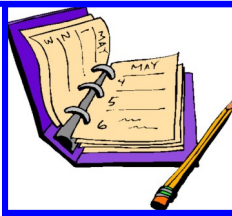

Well done **Mihira!**



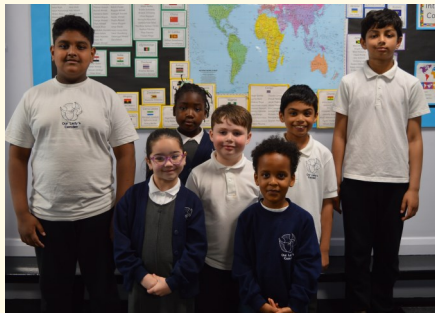
The winner of the Friday newsletter slip prize this week is **Riley** in **Y3**.
