Parents can also help by running stalls on the day. Please contact the school office to volunteer.

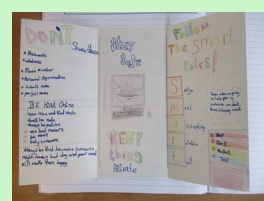
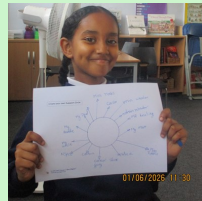

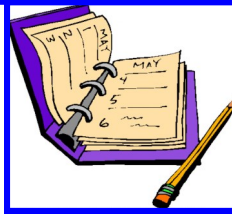
